4. The Official Delegation

- b. Coaches for athletes
- c. Administrators for athletes
- d. Medical officers including medical practitioner, sport psychologist and sport physiotherapist

The Official Delegation is invited to all official functions including the Opening Ceremony as well as the Victory Banquet.

5. Entry Forms

The submission deadline for Form B, C and D is on or before November 15, 2024.

7. Official Hotels

As HKSAR Government has imposed a 3% tax on hotel accommodation per room per night effective January 1, 2025, there will be a slight difference in room charges as those stated in Bulletin 1.

10. Visa Information

No visa for entry is required for more than 170 countries/regions. However, the visa-free period may vary among different countries/ regions. The entry forms are NOT valid as visas. All countries/ regions should confirm visa information independently by checking "Part II of Visit Visa/ Entry Permit Requirements for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region" from the Immigration Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/visit-transit/visit-visa-entry-permit.html.

Application form could be found in www.immd.gov.hk/eng/forms/hk-visas/visit-transit.html. The application process may take more than 6 weeks' time. All visa applications must be submitted to HKCTBC at least 2 months before the commencement of the championship to facilitate our processing with the HKSAR Immigration Department and NOT to the Chinese Embassy in your country/regions. We earnestly request that all filled out forms should be emailed to HKCTBC.

11. Transportation

Pick-up will be arranged for all participating teams and registered guests/supporters to and from Hong Kong International Airport, Macao Ferry and the Train Station to the three Official Hotels. There will be designate shuttle bus to and from Dorsett Kai Tak Hotel, Harbour Plaza 8 Degree Hotel and Kowloon Shangri-La Hotel to Top Bowl.

Airport/ Macao Ferry/ Train Station pick-up service will NOT be provided if participating teams do not stay in the three Official Hotels. Hong Kong International Airport is around 45 minutes driving distance to the three Official Hotels. Kindly submit

This fee covers accreditation card, transportation, participation in Opening Ceremony and the Victory Banquet.
