# 2025 IBF YOUTH WORLD CUP - HELSINGBORG, SWEDEN

The IBF is pleased to announce that the 2025 IBF Youth World Cup, presented by QubicaAMF, will be held in Helsingborg, Sweden from the  $15^{th} - 22^{nd}$  June 2025. The first Bulletin with information will be issued shortly.

# 2025 IBF WORLD CUP - HONG KONG CHINA

The 2025 IBF World Cup, presented by QubicaAMF, will be held in Hong Kong, China, from the  $5^{th} - 14^{th}$  January 2025. Currently there are 32 federations (31 men, 22 women) who have submitted an intention to participate. Federations that intend to participate in the Championships and have not yet submitted their (Form A) are requested to do so as soon as possible. ### 2025 IBF PARA WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - HONG KONG CHINA

The 2025 IBF Para World Championships will be held in Hong Kong, China, from the  $17^{th} - 24^{th}$  January 2025. ### **BOWLING BALLS AT IBF EVENTS**

Only USBC-approved bowling balls are allowed and MUST have the manufacturer's name, product name and serial number clearly visible. The serial number must be the original serial number. Any ball that does not meet this requirement will not be allowed for play.

### **IBF STATEMENT ON STRING MACHINE SPECIFICATIONS**

In 2020, the International Bowling Federation (IBF) introduced a set of specifications for string machines, approving their use for sport leagues and competitions worldwide. Since then, many IBF member federations have embraced these standards and adopted the ruling within their respective countries. In mid-2023, the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) established its own string machine specifications and approval processes for the U.S. market, which differ from the IBF's original specifications.

We would like to take this opportunity to update and clarify the IBF's current position on string machines. Our stance is as follows:

The original IBF string machine specifications and approval from 2020 will remain in effect for all IBF-affiliated sport leagues and local competitions within IBF member federations. We continue to encourage our member federations to adopt these standards to maintain consistency across our sport.

Moving forward, for all IBF-sanctioned titled events that are held in centres equipped with string machines, those machines must comply with IBF/USBC specifications. This dual compliance will help ensure greater consistency and fairness at the highest levels of competition, aligning with the expectations of both global and U.S.-based participants.

Technological advancements have always played a vital role in the growth and preservation of our sport, from the introduction of automatic pinsetters and scoring systems to the development of synthetic lanes and evolving bowling ball technology. The advancements in string machine technology are in line with this tradition, representing another step forward in modernizing the sport while maintaining its integrity.
