**All room rates are per night per room and include breakfast.** Please understand that these rates will not be available for reservations made directly at the hotels and that we can not provide a shuttle service from/to the airport or from/to the bowling centre for federations having decided to stay in any other hotel.

**All reservations must be made through the Host Tournament Committee with Form B and have to be pre-paid to the Host Tournament Committee by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026.**

Reservations are subject to availability and will be guaranteed only after full payment of the hotel fees.

## 3. The Bowling Centre

The Centre “Max Munich Bowling” with 30 QubicaAMF lanes was opened in 2010 and has been the place of the European Seniors Bowling Championships in 2013.

The centre provides a restaurant, an outside terrace as well a bus stop and a big parking lot just outside of the main entrance. A variety of food and refreshments will be available at reasonable prices.

A ball paddock with customary amenities will be made available to the Athletes and Teams on an exclusive basis from 2 days before the first day of the Competition through to its completion.

Spectators will have the choice to follow the competition next to the lanes, to have a look at it from upstairs or to move to quieter areas in or outside the Centre. In total, there will be capacity for at least 400 spectators.

## 4. Munich Area


The city of Munich is the third largest town in Germany with 1.4 million inhabitants, offering a large variety of tourist attractions. It has an international airport with direct connections to many destinations worldwide.

Brunnthal is a small suburb of Munich with 6,000 inhabitants, being the home of Max Munich Bowling since 2010.

Munich weather in October is typically cool and transitional, with average daytime highs around 10-14°C (50-57°F) and chilly nights dropping to 4-7°C (39-45°F), with chances of rain and crisp air.

Public transportation is available throughout the whole city of Munich and its suburbs with more than 100 Underground and Railway stations next to every Place of Interest. Services are available all day long.

World Cup guests staying at the Leonardo Munich City East hotel will receive tickets for trains and buses all around the greater Munich area throughout their stay free of charge.



## 5. Facilities / Services

### Website

## **Arrival and Departure transfers**

All delegations staying at one of the official hotels will be met at Munich International Airport (MUC) upon arrival and will be transferred to the bowling centre to unload their bowling equipment and further on to their hotel. Federations must provide their flight arrival and departure times with Form D to make this service work properly.

Departure transfers will be provided from the official hotels to the airport only. Players must make sure that all bowling equipment will be taken to their hotel before the Victory banquet. Assistance for transfer of bowling equipment to the Leonardo hotel will be provided on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> October 2026.

## **Equipment storage**

Bowling equipment can be stored in a designated area at Max Munich Bowling from 11<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> October 2026. Federations wishing to have their equipment delivered to the bowling center are requested to contact the centre management in advance by email at [info@maxmunich-bowling.de](mailto:info@maxmunich-bowling.de).

## **Registration and Team Managers Meeting**

Each participant is required to register in person with his/her passport at the Bowling Centre during 12<sup>th</sup> October 2026 from 10.00 to 18.00 o'clock.

The Team Managers Meeting will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2026 from 18.00 o'clock at Max Munich Bowling. Each participating federation must attend with a maximum of 2 representatives

You do not have to bring flags or a CD with your national anthem with you.

## **Pro Shop**

Pro Shop services including a ball spinner will be available on site throughout the event.

## **Victory Banquet**

The Victory Banquet will be held on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2026 from 19.00 o'clock at Max Munich Bowling with a variety of delicious buffets. It is complimentary for all registered players, coaches, officials, supporters and media representatives.

Extra tickets for the Victory Banquet can be purchased at the Team Managers Meeting. The price for extra tickets will be announced with bulletin #3 in August 2026.

## **Unofficial Practice**

Lanes will be available for unofficial practice on Saturday 10th October and Sunday 11th October from 10.00 to 18.00 and Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October from 10.00 to 22.00 o'clock. The lane pattern in the unofficial practice will not be the official Championship pattern.

Federations can book their lanes for unofficial practice via a link provided in Bulletin #2 or via E-Mail to [counter@maxmunich-bowling.de](mailto:counter@maxmunich-bowling.de). The price will be 36,- Euro per lane and hour to be paid directly to the bowling centre on site. Spots for the unofficial practice will be available on a first come, first served basis.

## 6. Fees

### Entry Fee

The IBF World Cup 2026 entry fee is **300 USD** per person for all players, coaches and officials as members of the official delegation.

The entry fee for supporters and credentialed media representatives is **200 USD** per person. These fees cover participation, accreditation card, participation in Opening Ceremony and the Victory Banquet as well as transportation from/to Munich airport if staying at one of the official hotels.

### Hotel Fees

Federations will receive an invoice after having submitted their forms.

### Form B: Hotel form

The deadline for Form B is **30<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.

**Please return this form even if you choose to accommodate your delegation at another hotel than the official hotels.**

All reservations must be made through the Host Tournament Committee with Form B and have to be pre-paid to the Host Tournament Committee. Reservations are subject to availability. The Host Tournament Committee will try to handle your reservations for the requested hotel. However, we must reserve the right to change your reservation to another hotel, if necessary due to limited availability. We can not provide a shuttle service from/to the airport or from/to Max Munich Bowling for federations having decided to stay in any other hotel.

**Federations sending the Hotel Form later than 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026 cannot expect to be accommodated in the official hotels and cannot expect the special IBF World Cup rates.**  
These special rates will not be available for reservations made directly at the hotels.
